 SINGAPORE – Two men, aged 26 and 58, are assisting with police investigations for allegedly causing hurt to a 56-year-old security officer at a Kitchener Road condominium in Little India on Sunday morning May 7 2023.

Background of Incident

- a) The incident happened around 6.50 am on Sunday morning May 7 2023.
- b) In the footage provided by the association, two men are seen swinging their fists at Mr Suraskumar, who fall backwards against the condominium's vehicle gantry near its entrance.
- c) A police report has been lodged and Mr Suraskumar is currently recovering from the attack, the statement added.
- d) Investigations are ongoing.

Objective of Training Package
